ADVISORY NOTICE FOR AGRICULTURAL ENGINES

Airborne Toxic Control Measure (ATCM) for Stationary Diesel Engines

January 2008

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR OWNERS AND OPERATORS OF STATIONARY AND PORTABLE DIESEL AGRICULTURAL ENGINES GREATER THAN 50 HORSEPOWER

REQUIREMENT FOR ENGINE REGISTRATION

The purpose of this advisory is to alert owners and operators of agricultural engines to the registration requirements mandated by recently adopted State law.

In response to this State law, the Placer County Air Pollution Control District (District) is required to have owners/operators of new and existing agricultural diesel engines rated at 50 horsepower or greater register their engines with the District by **March 1, 2008.** Owners are encouraged to register their engines as soon as possible to meet the compliance deadline. A registration application is enclosed. You must complete this form for all diesel engines used at your facility, except those that propel vehicles. Failure to apply for registration by March 1, 2008 may result in enforcement action, including monetary fines.

In addition to registration, the law required engines to:

- Be equipped with a non-resetting hour meter and
- Meet the new emission standards by the compliance schedule in the table shown on the reverse side of this advisory.
