

Two workshop exercises were conducted, where each team worked to identify




land uses and scale of development in each segment within their Plan Areas. Update at the beginning of the Workshop included:

Plan Area Team Break-Out Sessions

Exercise #1 - Town Center/Neighborhood Use Considerations Goal: Each Team was to come to a consensus on land uses and scale of development in Plan Area.





- Understanding the characteristics, role of, and opportunities in each Plan Area's town centers/neighborhoods and discuss "use category" for basic land uses.
- Identifying preferred land uses and scale for areas including: gathering places, master plan/resort areas, mixed-use, gateways, service, office, etc.

Exercise #2 - Rural/Residential Use Considerations

Goal: Each Plan Area Team to come to a consensus on land uses and scale of rural residential development in Plan Area.

This exercise included discussions on:

 Understanding the characteristics, role of, and opportunities in each Plan Area's rural/residential areas and identify areas within the rural/residential landscape for special use considerations.
