In the winter of 2009, the State Water Resources Control Board suspended the review of proposed regulations and the environmental review due to comments received. Since that time, new State Board staff has been working with interested groups to revise the regulations. New conceptual proposals have been developed that should address concerns while still providing appropriate protection of the State's waters.

The Placer County Public Works Department will give an update on the status of the EIR and Transportation Element, discussing briefly the proposed project.
