A. Eden Roc II:

This matter was presented to the MAC on November 5, 2008 and is being reheard at the request of the Placer County Planning Department. Applicant proposes a Subdivision and Conditional Use Permit for a six-lot residential Planned Development with one open space lot (4.49 acres), on 39.38 acres. A Rezoning is proposed. The site has two zone districts: RA-BX 20 acre min with a PD of 0.44 and RA-BX 4.6 acre min. The Rezoning proposes to add a Planned Development designation of 0.44 (PD 0.44) to the existing RA-BX-4.6 acre minimum zone district. A Variance is also proposed to reduce the Planned Development Open Space requirement from 20% to 11.4%. The site is located at
