A regular meeting of the West Placer Municipal Advisory Council was held on Wednesday, November 9, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. at the Creekview Ranch Middle School, Roseville, Ca.

1. Call to Order: the meeting was called to order at 7:00

2. Pledge of Allegiance: Vice Chair Walt Wylie led the pledge.

3. Approval of the Agenda. Darryl Osborne moved to approve the agenda with the removal of Item 8. Claudette seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

4. Approval of the Minutes of September 14, 2011. Carolyn Riolo moved to approve the minutes of September 14, 2011. Darryl seconded. Motion carried 4-0

5. Public Comment: Kirk Ransome from the Humane Society reported that they currently have 3 officers to assist with animal control and will be hosting a fund raising concert "Concert of the Blues" at DeWitt center. The phone number is 530 823-6328.

6. Supervisor Report: Supervisor Duran announced a review of the bond structure covering the Morgan Creek/Morgan Greens/Doyle Ranch/Sun Valley Oaks developments and savings of approximately \$2000 per unit over a 10 year period. Also he was happy to announce the approval of the funding for the Cook Riolo Replacement Bridge with a spring 2012 start. Also the design of the Walerga park (regional) is now out.

7. Public Safety:

A. County Sheriff's Department. Officer Bell reported the continued theft of copper and also car break-ins in Willow Creek and Morgan Creek. Lynne Harrison passed out a list of important web sites and phone numbers to share with the community. .

B. Cal-Fire : Chief Lopez reported that not much was happening in the way of fires. The station construction has begun but is progressing slowly.

9. Informational Item

a. Unauthorized Trees at Sabre City Park: Presented by John Ramirez (Parks Administrator)

Trees have been planted in the open space at Sabre City Park without the knowledge or authorization of Placer County. The County Parks Division will be discussing measures to be taken to address these trees.

Mr. Ramirez stated first that they would be going to bid on a portion of the Dry Creek community Park in mid December. He went on to explain the issues surrounding the open space in Sabre City and the plans for addressing concerns. The County previously removed the “clubhouse” leaving an open space in the center entrance area at Sabre City. (a 5 acre park area). The plan is to place a 24 x 24 pavilion picnic area with playground area. Currently some residents have planted trees which are less than desirable and the County would like to have the neighbors remove or they will remove the trees and plant the appropriate trees for the area. To explain this process they are current arranging for a community meeting of Sabre City residents.
