Overview of Placer County Veteran’s Services provided by John Melrose. The office helps facilitate the beginning process of filing claims, collecting proper documents and assisting with the application. They provide a conduit between veterans and the County. They assist veterans understand letters they receive from the VA; meet with local, State and Federal legislature to promote veteran issues.

Services they provide assistance in are:

- Non-service connected pension
- Education benefits
- Health Care
- VADP (VA dental plan)

They also have a California College Fee Waiver program that benefits spouses and children of U.S. veterans. Students meeting the eligibility criteria may get their college tuition fees waived if they attend a California Community College, a California State University or a University of California campus.

- The City is looking at the medical marijuana ordinance and possibly banning it altogether.
- Approved portion of the budget on June 10, 2014. The City's financial condition is ok.
- The 2016/2016 fiscal year is looking at a potential downturn.
- A couple businesses have closed: Staples and Mimi's
- There is a potential big employer coming to Lincoln bringing 100 new jobs.
- The City received money from the Indian Community for the fire department to purchase gear.
- The City will be having their annual fireworks show. They City will be covering the cost of providing safety.

- The Lincoln Blvd restoration plan still is not complete. Phase I will be from 7th Street to Highway 193
- Family Dollar store moving into the old ACE Hardware building.
- Sewer line project is on schedule
- Village 5 is moving along. This will consist of a sports complex
- Village 7 is slowly progressing
- Village 1 moving along. They are negotiating with the County. The area is from 193 east to Sierra College and north to Virginiatown.
- Lincoln Farmer's Market will be starting soon.
