

Hi Laura, I am unaware of the odor complaint to Placer and to my knowledge; TRPA has not had any odor complaints for at least the last 4 years. Re VMT: TRPA conducts threshold status updates every 5 years. The last one, which remains current until another evaluation is completed, indicates that VMT is "Out-of Attainment". The following chart shows TRPA current AQ status for each indicator. Visibility and Traffic volumes are the only indicators that are "In-Attainment". The full AQ report can be found at
