1. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM by President Bob Perro who led the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Approval of Minutes of May 18, 2015 meeting:

- a. A motion was made by Len Valasek and seconded by Don Jones to approve the minutes as written with one minor correction, correct the spelling of Richard Lercari's name. The minutes were approved by vote of the members present.

4. Public Comment:

- a. Lincoln Fire Department; members Billy Hartley, Paul McCracken, and Louis Robertson; with retired Fire Fighter Sam Silvas; advised they hold their annual "Roll Call Dinner" for retired and transferred Fire Fighters the 1st Tuesday in February, this coming year February 2, 2016. They requested the date and asked for a fee waiver. They were advised to submit the request to the County to be added to the next scheduled meeting's agenda. It would be voted on then, September 21, 2015, by members of the board.

5. Information/Non-Action Item:

- a. Work Orders, the report was reviewed and accepted.
- b. Update on the range replacement:
 - 1) Delivery is scheduled for Tuesday July 21, 2015. Installation would immediately follow.
- c. Rides for Veterans:
 - 1) President Bob Perro advised the County has set the program in motion as of July 1, 2015. Applications are available through the American Legion website and must be filled out and submitted prior to receiving approval for a ride.

6. Action Items:

- a. Wire Pro security camera quote:

- 1) Bob Bruce presented a quote for 5 cameras, required hardware, DVR and security box for the DVR to the Veteran groups. The cost of cameras and hardware is proposed at \$2050.76. A separate quote for labor to install was proposed at \$2250.00.
 - 2) After discussion of the quote Don Jones advised he would be seeking an additional quote from Sonitrol.
 - 3) Further discussion continued over the cost and how to fund the project. The County recommends the Veteran groups pay for the system to expedite the acquisition rather than go through the 3-5 year bid/allocate/approve/purchase program the County would require.
 - 4) A proposal to request funding assistance from the other Prime users of the Hall was made by all parties.
 - b. Manuel Nevarez advised the board that several windows on the east side of the Hall are wired shut due to missing window latches. Duane Espinoza said he would look into getting them repaired.

 - 1) James Beswick, Commander of the American Legion Post told the members of an upcoming event, "Veteran's Mental Health", scheduled for Wednesday, August 19, 2015 at 7:00PM. 
