### Minimum requirements:

- Windows 98, Windows 2000, XP, Vista, or Windows 7
- High-speed Internet connection (dial-up isn't fast enough)
- 25 MB available disk space


**Step 1: Enter your Email address and Library Card Number. Click 'Submit'.**

**Step 2: Now click the link: ELF browser**




**Step 3: Open the zip file by clicking OPEN.**

**Step 6: Now you are at the 'InstallShield Wizard' for the browser. Click NEXT.**




**Step 7: Read and accept the ELF End User License Agreement.**




**Step 8: After accepting, click NEXT.**




**Step 9: Now you are on the Program Maintenance screen. Leave the options as they are and simply click NEXT.**
