(STATE CLEARINGHOUSE NO. 2008102102) MITIGATED NEGATIVE
DECLARATION

ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION

- A) Adopt a Resolution adopting a Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) with the required findings for the Tahoe City Residential Erosion Control Project; and,
- B) Approve the Project as described in the MND and subject to all mitigations prescribed in the MND.

BACKGROUND / SUMMARY

The Tahoe City Residential Erosion Control Project is located in Placer County, California, on the north shore of Lake Tahoe in the residential community of Tahoe City. The project is generally bordered by Fairway Drive to the west; Bunker Drive to the north; Jackpine Street to the east; and SR 28 and SR 89 to the south (see attached location map).

The overall goal of the project is to design and implement erosion control and water quality improvement measures that will reduce the discharge of sediment and pollutants to Lake Tahoe from county rights-of-way in the Tahoe City Residential area. The Tahoe City Residential Erosion Control Project focuses on source control with the inclusion of conveyance improvements and treatment facilities to treat storm water runoff. The project will include, but is not limited to, culverts, drainage inlets, slotted drains, vegetated swales, rock lined channels, curb and gutter, and infiltration areas. The project will have a direct benefit to the quality of nearby waterways and ultimately Lake Tahoe as well as benefits to the natural environment.

ENVIRONMENTAL

A Mitigated Negative Declaration and Initial Study were prepared for this project pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). One comment was received after the comment period, which closed November 28, 2008; this comment has been appropriately addressed in the MND. Upon approval of the Mitigated Negative Declaration, the Notice of Determination will be processed.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total cost of the entire Tahoe City Residential Erosion Control Project is estimated to be \$4,000,000. The project is funded through California Tahoe Conservancy funding. Funding for the project is included in the Fiscal Year 2008-09 Budget.

been prepared by Placer County; and


WHEREAS, the design of the project is consistent with California Tahoe Conservancy

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of
Placer, State of California that this Board approves and adopts the Mitigated Negative
Declaration (State Clearinghouse No.2008102102) for the Tahoe City Residential Erosion
Control Project and makes the following findings:

1. The mitigated negative declaration has been prepared as required by law.
2. There is no substantial evidence in the record as a whole that the project as revised and mitigated may have a significant effect on the environment.
3. The mitigated negative declaration as adopted for the project reflects the independent judgment and analysis of Placer County, which has exercised overall control and direction of its preparation.
