SUBJECT: Approve the Renewal of Blanket Purchase Order No. 15536 as a Result of Competitive Bid No. 9670 with Kent's Oil Service for Asphalt Emulsion Delivered and Spread in the Maximum Amount of \$300,000.00

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**ACTION REQUESTED**

Approve the renewal of Blanket Purchase Order (BPO) No. 15536 as a result of competitive Bid No. 9670 with Kent's Oil Service of Stockton for asphalt emulsion delivered and spread in the maximum amount of \$300,000.00, and authorize the Purchasing Manager to sign the resulting BPO.

**BACKGROUND**

On March 25, 2008, your Board approved the first renewal of competitive Bid No. 9670 to Kent's Oil Service for asphalt emulsion delivered and spread for various road construction projects. As a result, BP015536 was issued for the period of April 1, 2008 through March 31, 2009. The Department of Public Works – Road Maintenance Division has requested to renew this BPO in the maximum amount of \$300,000.00.

Kent's Oil Service has agreed to renew for the exact same pricing, terms, and conditions as the previous agreement. Procurement Services determined that the pricing remains reasonable based on the various indices that are representative of the current market conditions affecting the cost of this material.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

The BPO resulting from this recommendation will total \$300,000.00 and will be effective from April 1, 2009, through March 31, 2010. The Department of Public Works' Fiscal Impact Statement is attached.
