ACTION REQUESTED:

Approve the attached ordinance with approval as submitted by the Civil Service Commission from their regular meeting held April 14, 2009 as delineated below:

In the Facility Services Department, the reclassification of one vacant Senior Information Technology Technician position, salary grade 112 (\$4919 - \$5979 monthly), to the classification of Senior Geographic Information System Technician, salary grade 112 (\$4919 - \$5979 monthly). Both senior-level classifications are pay Grade 112.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Personnel Department, in conjunction with the Information Technology (IT) Review Panel, conducted a classification review of the Senior Information Technology Technician position assigned to the Environmental Engineering division. The review and classification request has demonstrated to the Civil Service Commission that the duties performed are those ascribed to the Senior Geographic Information System (GIS) Technician classification and hereby submits the Civil Service Commission-approved reclassification for your Board's review and allocation approval.
